the studies united in this volume explore themes of community politics religion gender and social conflict and accommodation during the first decades of the reformation movement other chapters investigate historiographical themes especially the interpretation of early modern german history two longer chapters address european themes the historical sociology of early modern societies in terms of legal definitions of status and modern conceptions of economic class and the difference between central and western european development in a global context taken together the studies explore the transition zone between medieval and modern history in both microhistorical especially urban and regional and broadly comparative contexts some of the studies are supplementary to the author s books on the sixteenth century protestant reformation at strasbourg in southern germany and in the holy roman empire

the most accurate inventory of renaissance rhetoric yet attempted this substantially revised and expanded volume provides a complete list of the printed sources for study of the pervasive influence of rhetoric on renaissance culture it includes 1 717 authors and 3 842 rhetorical titles in 12 325 printings published in 310 towns and cities by 3 340 printers and publishers from finland to

mexico prior to 1700 the catalogue is presented in alphabetical order by author surnames with place printer date and library locations for each publication an extensive introduction explores the state of bibliography in renaissance rhetoric today

from 1575 to 1730 the citizens of the alsatian imperial city of colmar were divided between protestant and catholic communities plagued by chronic warfare and ultimately subjugated by the kingdom of france drawing on a rich collection of serial archival sources wallace reconstructs the collective biography of 6 700 civic officials merchants artisans and agricultural workers in order to examine the local impact of confessionalization in a religiously mixed town the effect of warfare on the economic interdependence of town and country and the tensions between french absolutism and traditional civic political culture economic historians scholars of the reformation and students of french and german history will find many valuable insights in this multifaceted analysis

protestant politics presents a new interpretation of the impact of the protestant reformation on the political culture and government of the holy roman empire it arose from a desire to re examine this subject which was long dominated by the views of leopold von ranke 1795 1886 in the light of two recent developments the liberation of pre modern european history from its long domination by the idea of the nation state and the recognition of the reformation as a social movement protestant politics is also the first narrative of the german reformation based on original sources in more than half a century the particular approach of protestant politics is to map the collision of the relatively unified protestant movement with the dispersed multi layered structure of authority and power in the late medieval holy roman empire the narrative thread which holds together the story s levels local provincial regional and imperial is the career of jacob sturm 1489 1553 of strasbourg the leading protestant urban politician of the era the rhythm of his career from a heritage of local autonomy through the great peasants war of 1525 to the trans regional protestant alliance 1531 47 and then back again to the local and provincial politics of the 1550s mirrors the political career of german protestantism from its explosive beginnings through expansion defeat and a loss of dynamism this process shaped by the peculiar political structures and traditions of the empire not the theology of martin luther is responsible for german protestantism failure to develop a revolutionary potential similar to those of the french english and netherlandish protestant movements protestant politics is written for historians and for students and readers of history at all levels the quotes from original sources are all put into english and basis of interpretation is explained in a lengthy introduction protestant politics is a revisionist work on politics and religion in germany it will be of interest to students of german history late medieval and early modern german history german historiography and religion and politics

book review
